We love to help Carol Stream teachers and students make the most of their school year.

Teachers at Carol Stream schools are eligible to borrow materials from the Library with a Special Borrowing Account. (Ask your school's administration how to get started.) We have online resources and streaming services for video, music, and audiobooks, narrated video picture books, and research databases.

You can refer students who need extra help to our free, online, one-on-one homework help by live tutors. We can find appropriate books, movies, and other resources to help support your lesson plans and test prep. We also come to you for class visits! 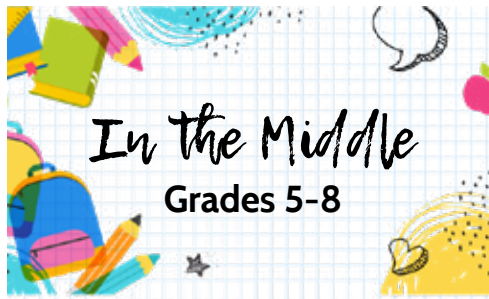
R: Homeschool Hangout: Nature Walk

All you need is your first name, last name, and email address. Your new profile can be made private and not searchable by search engines. You will be able to change privacy settings at any time on your Settings and Privacy page.

Search Libraries Throughout the US with WorldCat Discovery

95% of the items that CSPL cardholders request come from within our own library system, SWAN. However, sometimes we have to look in other Illinois or national libraries to find an item. WorldCat Discovery is a tool that allows us to search libraries throughout the United States and request items for our cardholders.

If you want to find an item outside our library system, we are happy to do the searching for you. But you can also submit requests for these items on your own. Enter your search in the box in the upper right corner of our website and select the Worldcat tab.
